
### Commonwealth is....

- 56 countries.
- 1/3 of the world population (2.7 out of 8.2 billion).
- 16 high-income countries, 16 upper middle-income countries, 17 lower middle-income countries, and 7 low-income countries.
- 2/3 of the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) (26 out of 39).
- both a major source and destination for international migration of health and care workers.


#### Global health workforce shortage is declining but...

#### main financial gap for achieving SDG 3: Health workforce



# A challenging environment...

- No prioritization of health over the past decade in Commonwealth lowincome countries
- Debt servicing has increased for many countries
- ODA an important source of funding for health for many low-income countries is declining.
- US aid freeze





# "Hegemonic policy" and disruption...

 8 out of the top 10 countries receiving US aid for health are Commonwealth countries

#### Nigeria:

- US aid for health contributed to 512 million USD in 2023.
- Nigerian lawmakers approved an additional \$200 million for the health sector, saying the funds would be used to "fill the gap" left by the suspension of US foreign aid.

## Issues for consideration...

### **Sustainable Financing**

- Evaluate additional source of revenues
- Prioritizing health & health and care workforce in government budget
- Better aligning ODA (only a small fraction of health ODA goes to health and care workforce).
- Encouraging co-investments within the context of international migration of health and care workers (e.g. bilateral agreements and co-investment between source and destination countries).
- Improving budget execution rate

### Sustainable health and care workforce

- Invest better in health and care workers
- Advance integrated health services primary care teams play a key role - aligned with the Lusaka agenda.
- Strengthening the implementation of the WHO Code of Practice on the International Recruitment of Health Personnel.
- Expanding employment opportunities through Partnerships for Public Purpose
- Identifying efficiency measures to optimize the health and care workforce performance, quality and impact.
