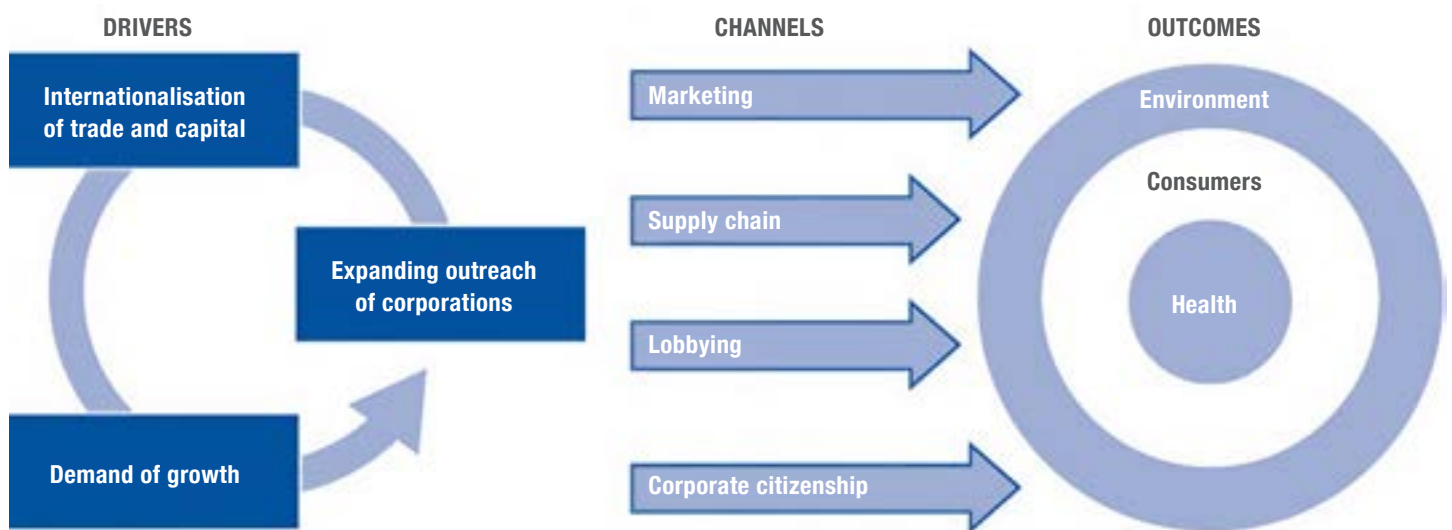

Objectives of the Forum

1. To raise awareness of the commercial determinants of health.
2. To highlight the four goals of the World Health Organization's program of action on Economic and Commercial Determinants of Health (to strengthen the evidence base; develop tools and capacity to address the commercial determinants; convene partnerships and dialogue; raise awareness and advocacy).
3. To propose actionable recommendations for Commonwealth Health Ministers on innovative strategies to address these four goals across the Commonwealth.

The 2022 CCSPF, hosted by the Commonwealth Association for Paediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition (CAPGAN), on behalf of the CHPA, will discuss aspects of how addressing commercial determinants of health can improve the health and wellbeing of the people of the Commonwealth. In the context of continued progress toward Universal Health Coverage in the Commonwealth, and with experiences gained from COVID-19, the 2022 CCSPF will discuss both the challenges faced and innovative approaches to enhance positive aspects and reduce negative impacts of private sector activities on health.
